Library Board of Trustees Meeting December 9, 2024

The Knoxville Public Library Board of Trustees met at the library on Monday, December 9, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. Members present were Jan Evans, Erin McBride, Lindsey Carlson, John Mertz, Laura Kendrick, Elly Shaw, and Dave Garcia.

The meeting was called to order by Lindsey Carlson. Mertz moved, McBride seconded to approve the minutes of the November 11, 2024 meeting as mailed. Motion passed unanimously.

Roslin gave the librarian's report for November 2024. Total circulation was 2,648 printed materials, 570 non-print materials, while downloadable materials numbered 1,593 items. Computer usage was 314 with 1,031 recorded usage of the wifi. The AWE computer count was still not working. Total number of visits for November was 1,911 (average of 83 visits a day).

The library held regular programming as well as new such as the special Fairy Tales ST that drew boys and girls, LEGO Play, and a scavenger hunt. School visits reached 336 students and 25 educators. City and county budget planning is underway with meetings scheduled next week. A sub-committee was formed to plan the city budget. The library hours will adjust for the holiday break and offer additional programs for kids and families: craft drop-in day, gingerbread houses decorating, and bingo.

Under Media Strategy Plan, the library will publish its calendar for January and send it to the various media outlets. KNIA/KRLS reporter has interviewed staff regarding several programs. Programs are published on the city website.

Financial reports were not available. Evans moved, Kendrick seconded the approval for payment of bills for December. Motion passed unanimously, and a copy is attached to the minutes.

Under New Business, the board interviewed 3 new candidates for the library director position. After deliberation, McBride moved, seconded by Shaw to offer the position to candidate #4. Carlson will contact her in the morning for confirmation.
